The tale begins with a truck crash on an icy road along the Allegheny River, which allows a pack of wolves to escape into the wild. Hawk and Jimmy take on the task of tracking down the pack of wolves and bringing them to safety. Upon setting out on their voyage, Hawk and Jimmy have no idea what is awaiting them in the woods.

Along their journey, the men learn of potential poachers in the area and fear the harm they will cause the wolves. Hawk and Jimmy stumble upon one of the best hidden secrets of the woods, Miss Reba Snow. With the help of their wild, gun-slinging friend, they are able to venture into the woods with the hope of finding the wolves before the poachers do.

Brian A. Connolly graduated from Edinboro University in Pennsylvania, where he received the Finnegan Award for Poetry. He taught creative writing in public schools for 28 years and also served as a Project Adventure teacher.
